Arukore Simba Camp Serengeti

Central Serengeti, inside the national park

2°14' S · 34°50' E Serengeti

Open grassland, open sky, and nothing between your bed and the plains.

Arukore sits on open grassland in the heart of the Serengeti, 25 kilometres from Seronera airstrip. The tented suites are built around the view, with full panoramic windows that face the plains straight from the bed.

The camp is named after the nearby Arukore River, where the ancestors of the Ikoma people once hunted. There are no hills and no tree line to interrupt the sky, so evenings are spent around the fire with every star in place.

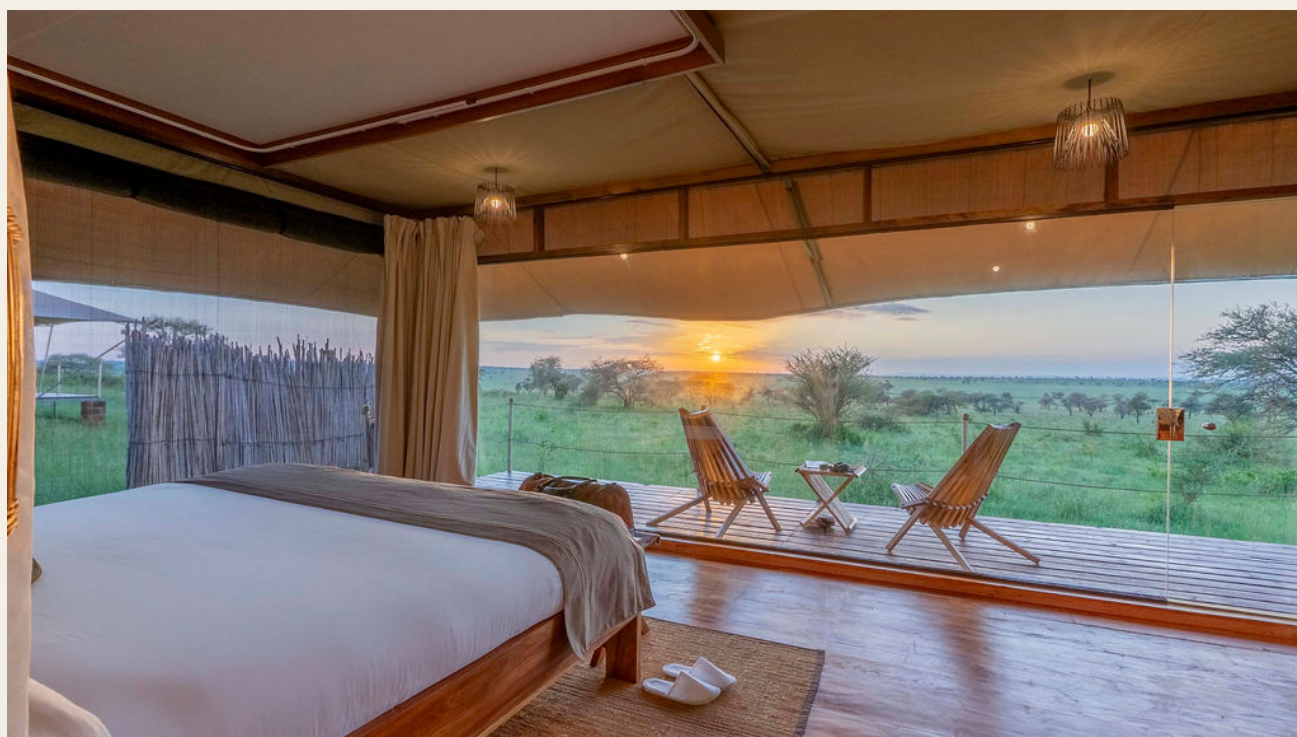

Spacious permanent tents built for the setting, decorated with local fabrics and hardwood furniture. Each has full panoramic windows, a private deck, an en-suite bathroom with an outdoor shower, and solar-heated water. Singles, twins and doubles.

Fresh bread and rolls baked every day, Tanzanian coffee and local herbal teas, and a flexible meal schedule that works around your drives. Vegetarian and gluten-free diets are always catered for, and the lunch boxes are worth taking.

Arukore is solar powered, without 24-hour electricity. Hair dryers aren't available, lighting is soft, and CPAP machines need their own battery.

Wi-Fi is free in the indoor common areas.

The camp is unfenced. After dark, our team walks you to and from your tent.

Serengeti nights get cold, even in summer. A fleece is worth packing.
