Olkambe Simba Lodge Tarangire

Olkambe Hills, inside Tarangire National Park

3°59'S · 35°55'E Tarangire

A hilltop inside Tarangire, with two lakes in the view.

Olkambe sits on the Olkambe Hills, inside the national park and nine kilometres from Sangaiwe Gate. From up here the land falls away on every side: Lake Burunge close by, Lake Manyara and its escarpment on the horizon, and Tarangire's baobab country filling everything in between.

The local name for this corner of the park is Chamchangeu, which means natural spring waters. The springs below the hill draw wildlife all year, so game viewing here often begins on your own balcony.

Permanently built tented suites, larger than the rooms at our Classic lodges, finished in hardwood with locally inspired detail. Good to know

Olkambe runs on solar power. Hair dryers aren't available, and CPAP machines need their own battery.

Wi-Fi is complimentary in the common areas.

Nights on the hill are cool from June to August, so bring a warm layer.
